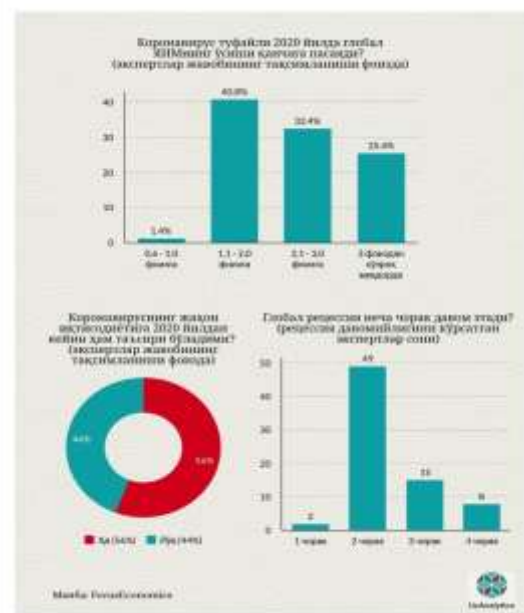
1. INTRODUCTION
