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Different Forms of Education: Prospects for Teaching Traditional, Online and Mixed Education with the Method of the "Cherry Blossom"

Stages of application of the method "Cherry blossom" in the educational process

Step 1. Students will first be introduced to a new topic and its basic concepts.

Step 2. Concepts of a new method used to strengthen new concepts and further enrich knowledge are given. For example, first write the topic to the king of cherries, write the branches of the topic in its paragraphs, and in the fruit its result, its concepts, features, and at the end of

the method draw conclusions and encourage the most active participants.

Step 3. To work on the method, students are divided into small groups and given the same diagrams as in Figure 1 for the method "Cherry Blossom" and are given an overview.



