

Five Important Initiatives - A Solid Foundation for the Future

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Abstract: This article reveals the role and importance of the work on the development of reading, information technology, music and sports in the development of young people on the basis of five important initiatives put forward by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. Mirziyoyev.

Keywords—initiative, reading, art, information technology, sports, enlightenment, music, personnel, research, decisions and decrees, women.

1. INTRODUCTION

Youth is the future of the country, our backbone and support for tomorrow. Any maturity used will determine the development and prospects of our country. To this end, our country is focused on the lofty goals of the future owners, the use of their talents and opportunities. The 5 important initiatives identified by the leadership of our country have brought the efforts in this direction to a new level. President of the Republic of Uzbekistan IA Karimov approaches the field of education from a national didactic point of view and describes its implementation: "Education contributes to the spirituality of the people of Uzbekistan in a creative way. It seems that the younger generation has all the good opportunities, their professionalism and skills are constantly improving, the older generation is always aware of their experience and looks to the younger generation. On March 19, under the chairmanship of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev, held a dedicated video conference. 30% of the population of our country are young men and women aged 14 to 30 years. Conduct job training and create conditions for professional development. At the same time, the organization of meaningful performance of the allotted time of young people is related to the topical issue. Young people's work is a spiritual start, and their immunity to various alien vices is just as strong. It is known that the leadership of our country has put forward 5 important initiatives aimed at implementing the work in the social, spiritual and educational spheres on the basis of new systems.

Material and Methods

1. The first initiative is to increase the interest and talent of young people in music, painting, literature, theater and other arts.
2. The second initiative is aimed at creating the necessary conditions for young people to exercise and show their abilities in sports.
3. The third initiative is aimed at promoting the effective use of computer technology and the Internet among the population and youth.
4. The fourth initiative is aimed at raising the morale of young people, the organization of systematic work to promote reading among them.

5. The Fifth Initiative addresses the issue of women's employment.



Results

This noble idea was launched during the visit of the President to the Syrdarya region, and in a short time great work was done. 300,000 copies of fiction were delivered to district and city libraries of Syrdarya region. Music and art schools were equipped with musical instruments and sports facilities. This work was continued in Namangan region, where the "Caravan of Enlightenment" was organized. 25,000 books, 80 types of sports equipment and musical instruments were delivered to young people. In short, these 5 initiatives have been met with great interest by our people, especially our youth. The meeting discussed the implementation of this practice in all regions of the country.

According to the first initiative, today only 130,000 boys and girls are enrolled in more than 800 cultural centers, 312 music and art schools in the country, most of which have textbooks and a set of notes. , musical instruments, furniture and equipment were not adequately provided.

The head of state instructed to study the material and technical base of local cultural centers, music and art schools and the state of their use, and to improve their activities. The Ministry of Culture and the Ministry of Public Education, together with the authorities, have been tasked to establish an additional 1,500 clubs in district (city) cultural centers and secondary schools based on the interests of young people. There was a need to establish amateur art groups,

youth theater studios and "Youth Clubs" in cultural centers, involving talented young people and local sponsors. Given the good results of bringing together well-known artists and talented artists as cultural assistants in the districts, instructions were given to spread this experience throughout the country. According to him, well-known artists are attached to the districts and cities as creative consultants, responsible for the development of culture and art in those areas, and the mayors of districts and cities provide financial and organizational support for this work.

Discussion

Attention was also paid to the issue of increasing the number of highly educated people in the field of music and art. The Ministries of Higher and Secondary Special Education and Public Education have been instructed to organize history classes on specific topics in museums, historical monuments, shrines and theaters.

Discussing the issues of the second initiative, it was noted that there are more than 12,000 sports facilities in the country, but the level of coverage of youth in physical culture and mass sports is insufficient. The level of equipping secondary schools with sports equipment is 56% in the country, including 12% in Surkhandarya region, 14% in Khorezm and 15% in Karakalpakstan. The meeting identified measures to involve young people in physical culture and sports. The deputy mayors of districts and cities on youth issues were instructed to study the interest of young people in sports and the level of equipment of sports facilities, to make proposals on this basis, to determine the source of funding for their implementation. The need to build small gyms and artificial turf from lightweight sandwich panels in remote villages, as well as the need to allocate land for entrepreneurs to build sports facilities. The NBU will provide soft loans to such entrepreneurs under the Youth is Our Future program. It was noted that the appointment of well-known athletes who have won international competitions to local sports schools, as well as targeted training of athletes in special correspondence departments of higher education institutions will give good results. Tasks have been given to increase the number of sports schools for children and teenagers.

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
