According to Article 77.2, he was sentenced to 10 years in prison for providing financial or property assistance to a party "whose activities are directed against the territorial integrity or political independence of the state". Article 77.3 for the recruitment, training or sending of a person "for his illegal participation in activities outside the Armed Conflict of the Republic of Latvia" provides for deprivation of liberty for up to 8 years.

18-A.da Latvia's symphonic orchestra was organized. Russia. In 2014, a legal framework was created that allows you to engage in free participation in battles on the territory of another state. For example, the formula of Part 2 of Article 208 of the Criminal Code of the Russian Federation has been amended: "participation in an armed formation not provided for by federal law, as well as participation in an armed formation not provided for by this state's legislation for

purposes contrary to the interests of the Russian Federation, is punishable by imprisonment.
